

# Polyapes Scout Camp Terms and Conditions

A weekend booking for Polyapes commences at 1800hrs Friday and ends at 1630hrs Sunday. Variations to these times will be chargeable. Whole, half site and whole week bookings are subject to negotiation. All bookings are to be made through the website. We do not take provisional bookings. The booking is confirmed on receipt of the deposit payment which is non refundable. Please ensure the means to pay is brought to camp, payment is required during your stay. A surcharge of £50 will be added to balance payments if this is not done. A cleaning charge of £100 will be payable if any building is not left in the condition it is found. The Wardens make an inspection of the site at the beginning of every camp any damage or breakages discovered during or at the end of camping will be the responsibility of all onsite that weekend.

Polyapes is run by volunteers wherever possible we will endeavour to have duty crew on site during your stay. However, sometimes this is not possible in this event you will be issued with an emergency contact number in the event of a problem arising during your stay. In the event of no duty crew being available it will be the responsibility of ALL on site to operate a rota to clean the toilets during your stay. Open fires are encouraged at Polyapes but only in existing fire scrapes and NOWHERE else.

The Management Committee has conducted a risk assessment of the site and identified hazards or potential hazards and wherever possible and practicable, either removed the potential hazard or put signs to warn of these hazards. Polyapes is an open field camping site as such users of the site should be aware of the inherent risks from uneven ground, flora and fauna.

"The Scout Association's policy is to safeguard the welfare of all members by protecting them from physical, sexual and emotional harm" All users of Polyapes will be expected to adopt a code of behaviour in line with the Associations.

Leaders: You are responsible for the supervision of your group while using the site and its facilities. NO adult within your party may have unsupervised access to any young person using the site unless that adult has been checked. All adults within your party must have been provided with a copy of the Scout Association's code of practice in dealing with young people.

In the event of an accident which requires emergency services being called a person must be sent to the main gate in Blundel Lane to show the emergency services in. These events should be reported to the duty crew (if one present or the emergency contact called). A clear path on the ridge must be maintained to enable emergency services to get to the Whistlefield.

Polyapes Management cannot be held responsible for any injuries caused, arising from the above. Leaders will be required to sign that they have accepted these as part of the terms and conditions.

I acknowledge and accept that all of the members of my party have been checked and have read the above and will abide by them.
